Wrestlers that enter should **not be potential entries for the PIAA post-season tournament.

Eligibility: Wrestlers may have a maximum of eight (8) varsity wins.

Weights: 108, 115, 122, 128, 134, 140, 147, 154, 162, 172, 184, 197, 222, 287

Rules: PIAA rules will apply.

Bout Times: 2-2-2, consolation bouts 1-2-2 (Double Elimination)

Seeding: Wrestlers will be seeded by winning percentage points. Top 32, 16, or 8 wrestlers will be seeded depending on the size of the bracket, to maintain optimal team separation.

**Varsity forfeits do not count as part of the seeding calculation.

- Minimum of ten (10) JV matches needed to be seeded.
- Varsity wins may be counted as JV win (varsity losses will not be counted).
- Subtract ten (10) points for each bout under 10 from the total percentage.

Examples:

Varsity Record 5-4

JV Record 6-1

Overall Record 11-1 (11 wins/12 bouts=91.67 seeding points)

Varsity Record 1-4

JV Record 4-3

Overall Record 5-3 (5 wins/ 7 bouts= 71.42 – 30 points= 41.42 seeding points)

Awards: Four places will be awarded
